Grain:

Open, with longer rays than red oak. Occasional crotches, swirls and burls.
Plain sawn boards have a plumed or flared grain appearance

Grade Specification for Unilin Timber Flooring

Standard grading allowance; maximum of 5% below the actual grade

A Grade

- Best appearance
- Selected for uniformity of light colour
- Slight variation in the natural sapwood colour
- Limited small character marks
- Pin Knots allowed
- Mineral Streaks of less than 3x25mm

B Grade

- Combination of A grade and B grades
- The most standard high grade hardwood flooring sold on the world market
- Excellent appearance
- Variation in the natural sapwood colour
- Limited character marks
- Sound knots of less than 5mm
- Mineral streaks of less than 3 x 100mm
- No stains, open checks or splits.

C Grade

- Variegated appearance
- All colour variations allowed
- Sound knots less than 20mm
- Mineral streaks allowed
- No open splits, holes or voids

D Grade

- Rustic appearance
- All colour variations allowed
- All characteristics of the species allowed
- A serviceable floor after knotholes, wormholes, checks splits and other imperfections are filled and finished.
